EXCLUSIONS

- Dependant drinkers are **NOT** suitable for LIAP
- Sexual Offenders
- Domestic Violence Offenders who have not addressed this risk area
- Serious mental illness (unless being effectively managed through treatment)



DIDP

EXCLUSIONS

- Offenders with serious mental health problems (unless being effectively managed by treatment)
- Domestic Violence Offenders



OSAP

EXCLUSIONS

- Acute drug or alcohol intoxication
- Serious mental illnesses (unless being effectively managed through treatment)

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LIAP



GOALS



- Reduce alcohol misuse which is related to criminal behaviour
- Address primary domain of alcohol misuse
- Increase knowledge base
- Challenge anti-social ways of thinking
- Reduce association with pro-criminal others
- Build self management, self regulation, social and problem solving skills



TARGET GROUP & CRITERIA



- Suitable for men and women
- OGRS 3: 35% - 75%
- Audit Score around 10-19 (considered individually)
- Offending is related to alcohol misuse
- Alcohol misuse has reached a stage where it will be harmful in terms of health, social functioning or offending



STRUCTURE

14



- 14 core sessions
- Offenders will be required to attend once a week
- There will also be pre-group and follow-up sessions which will be discussed with the offender and their Offender Manager.

DIDP



GOALS



- Reduce the risk of re-offending and harm to themselves and others
- Raise offenders awareness about the effects and consequences of drinking and driving and to move on to become legal and responsible drivers
- To explore the concept of 'safe' driving



TARGET GROUP & CRITERIA



- Suitable for men and women
- OGRS 3: Under 50%
- Drivers over the permitted limit
- Drivers who failed to provide a specimen
- Drivers in charge of a vehicle while unfit through drink



STRUCTURE

14



- 14 core sessions
- Offenders will be required to attend once a week
- There will also be pre-group and follow-up sessions which will be discussed with the offender and their Offender Manager.

OSAP



GOALS

- Eliminate or reduce participants drug or drink using behaviour
- Encourage offenders to consider the impact this behaviour has on their life and on others
- Encourage participants to reconsider the choices they make
- Prepare them for the painful memories which can re-emerge when substance misuse is reduced
- Help offenders examine their addictive behaviour and its link to criminal behaviour, identify risk factors and develop skills to prevent relapse



TARGET GROUP & CRITERIA



- OGRS 3: 50%+
- (when OGRS are 75+ OM should provide extra structured/motivational work)
- Offenders must be sufficiently stable & motivated (completed 16 week stabilisation period with OM)
- A problematic user of one or more substances
- Their current offence is substance specific
- Substance misuse acts as a dis-inhibitor to offending; or substance misuse is related to increased risk of serious harm



STRUCTURE

26



- 26 core sessions which are two and a half hours long.
- Offenders will be required to attend twice a wk
- There will also be Pre-group and follow-up sessions which will be discussed with the offender and their Offender Manager.
